## **Student Achievement Day Requirements**

(As listed in the CSMTA student Activities Manual on page 25. Revised 2007)

- 1. Two selections are played, one memorized.
- 2. Student names the key and plays the pentascale or scale of each piece.
- 3. Student prepares at least 2 Performance Options and 1 Related Option. Each Local Association will determine limits for Performance and Related Options in order to accommodate their individualized programs.

## A. PERFORMANCE OPTIONS: 2 required, maximum of 5

- 1. Additional piece, memorized or not memorized.
- 2. Scales
- 3. Chords
- 4. Arpeggios
- 5. Sight Reading (at two levels below entered level)
- 6. Improvisation
- 7. Play from a Lead Line adding accompaniment
- 8. Collaborative Performance (accompanying, duet, 2 or more students)
- 9. Performance on a second instrument (includes vocal solo)
- 10. Transposing
- 11. Dance
- 12. Conducting
- 13. Other

## B. RELATED OPTIONS: 1 required, maximum of 4

- 14. Written Theory Test
- 15. Terms and Sign
- 16. Music History Test
- 17. Written Ear Training Test
- 18. Original composition (written/printed) any instrument
- 19. Written Project; composers, music history, scrapbook, etc.
- 20. Written Review of a live performance or a recording.
- 21. Construction Project: mobiles, Games, Something "built" related to music
- 22. Art Related to Music: picture, poster, drawing, collage, etc.
